Second Annual Midwest Campus Safety Summit coming to Ball State University

MUNCIE, Ind.—The second annual Midwest Campus Safety Summit, a regional conference focused on preventing and responding to gender-based violence on college campuses, will be April 12-13 at the L.A. Pittenger Student Center at Ball State University.

The conference, organized by a Jana's Campaign, Inc., a national non-profit organization focused on providing quality educational programming that prevents gender and relationship violence, will provide up-to-date information for administrators, faculty members, counselors, residence hall staff and students interested in gender-based violence prevention.

The summit is the result of a collaborative relationship between Ball State and Jana's Campaign, Inc. Utilizing expertise and knowledge of the field. Other colleges, universities, and genderbased advocacy groups are participating as supporters and collaborators for this project.
