CHICAGO (July 2, 2018)—The **Glenwood Sunday Market Wine Stroll** returns to Rogers Park on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>July 22 from 11 a.m.-2 p.m</u>. Attendees can stroll the cobblestone arts district and sample more than 60 different wines from around the world, all while benefitting the Glenwood Sunday Farmers Market's local food access programs.

Wine aficionados will begin their tasting tour at **Rogers Park Social**, where they will pick up a souvenir tasting glass before strolling along Glenwood Avenue for outdoor samplings of more than 60 wines, guided by wine experts set up along the route.
