MUNCIE, Indiana— Students from Ball State University's Department of Theatre and Dance recently attended the Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival (KCACTF), bringing home a variety of awards and nominations on regional and national levels.

Two of the department's noteworthy achievements include senior musical theatre major and Davis, California, resident Devon Hayakawa's award for best dramaturg in the region for her work on the show *Twilight: Los Angeles, 1992*.
