Rogers Park kicks off Live Love Shop Rogers Park holiday rebate program during Small Business Saturday, November 24 with special discounts at dozens of independent shops

Live Love Shop Rogers Park runs Nov. 24-Dec. 31, 2018

CHICAGO (July 18, 2018)—Rogers Park Business Alliance (RPBA), the chamber of Chicago's diverse Rogers Park neighborhood, launches its annual <u>Live Love Shop Rogers Park</u> holiday rebate program on <u>Small Business Saturday, November 24</u>. Dozens of unique independent businesses in the neighborhood will be offering special discounts and promotions.

Shoppers are encouraged to stop by the neighborhood's **Small Business Saturday welcome station** at Heartland Cafe (7000 N. Glenwood Avenue) from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. on Nov. 24 to pick up a free shopping bag filled with goodies, a map of "Rogers Park Gems" highlighting area attractions, and a list of business offers. Past participating businesses include Bark Place, ChiTown Magpie, Empirical Brew Pub, Jessica's Western Wear and Nodd Pottery.

The Live Love Shop Rogers Park holiday rebate program runs from Nov. 24 through Dec. 31, 2018. For more information and official rebate rules, visit rpba.org/live-love-shop.

Live Love Shop Rogers Park offers rebates to shoppers who patronize independently owned businesses in Rogers Park during the holiday season. From Saturday, Nov. 24 through Monday, Dec. 31, customers who shop at independently owned Rogers Park stores are eligible for a rebate based on the total amount spent. (A map of neighborhood boundaries is available at online at rpba.org/live-love-shop.) Those who collect \$100 or more in receipts will receive a \$25 rebate, and those with receipts totaling \$150 or more will receive a \$50 rebate. To qualify for the rebate, an official form and original receipts must be turned in to the Rogers Park Business Alliance by 4 p.m. on Friday, January 11. Rebate forms will be available for download online at rpba.org/live-love-shop or for pickup at the RPBA office (1448 W. Morse Avenue) starting at the end of October.
