MUNCIE, Indiana— Levi Jones, Ball State University sophomore from Portage, Michigan, received first place in informative speaking and long read response, third place in extemporaneous speaking and fifth place in persuasive speaking on February 17 at the Indiana Forensic Association State Championship in Muncie, Indiana.
