MUNCIE, Indiana—Frank Zabilka, Ball State University senior and Department of Theatre and Dance cabaret singer from Lamont, Illinois, has helped write lyrics for Ball State's third official song, "We Fly."

Performed by about 20 students for the first time at the "We Fly" brand launch party in November, the University community has quickly embraced the anthem. The cabaret students have sung the anthem at their concerts in Indianapolis, Joe's Pub at the famed Public Theater in New York City, and several University events. They will sing it together one last time at their Commencement ceremony on May 5.
